Who certifies the courses?

Is there a local representative?

What is the duration of a course? Courses are downloaded from the Supply Chain Smart Learner Management System (LMS). Each course consists of 8 lessons which can be downloaded individually. How do I become certified?

How long do I have to complete the course?

The ideal timeframe to complete any of the certifications is in 18 months
